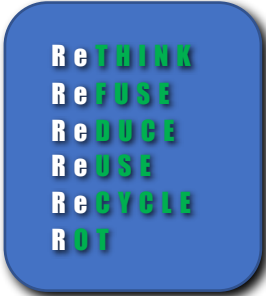

In addition to all the materials we recycle, we loan out recycling containers, sell compostable service ware, and can support your Zero Waste events. We are happy to speak to your organization or group about recycling. We also have scholarships for training in energy efficiency and renewable energy, climate change, and resource use reduction.

Don't just recycle, *RECYCLE RIGHT!* It's simple as 1 – 2 – 3:

1. Know what to throw.
2. Empty, clean, dry.
3. Sort carefully.

MATERIALS TAKEN AT FRIENDS OF RECYCLING (2.5 Mile Small Tracts Rd.)

Help us recycle 100% of what we take! PLEASE CLEAN all tin and aluminum cans, REMOVE paper labels, flatten cardboard, and carefully SORT all recyclables.

PAPER PRODUCTS

White paper: Any white paper that is not shiny, including envelopes with windows.

Low grade/mixed paper: ** IS NO LONGER ACCEPTED (no longer recyclable).

Cardboard: Corrugated paper boxes - look for ripple layers. *Must be flattened.*

Shredded white paper: White paper shredded into strips. *Must be bagged.*
No cross-shredded paper, it is too small to recycle.

Newspaper: Newsprint only.



METAL PRODUCTS

Copper & brass: Accepted anytime.

Aluminum cans: *Please rinse.*

Tin cans: *Please clean & remove labels.*
No aerosol cans.

Refrigerators & freezers: \$50 fee
Please drop off when the Center is staffed.

Washers, dryers, & electric ranges: \$20 fee
Please drop off when the Center is staffed.

Electronics: *June 5-6 10-2 .40/lb.*

Scrap Box: *New in 2019. Used items in good condition.*

PLASTIC PRODUCTS

Please check the # on bottom in the "chasing triangle". We only take:



- #1** Clear/clear-colored plastic bottles
 - #2** Cloudy milk jugs and colored containers
- Please rinse. DISCARD caps & lids.*

OTHER MATERIALS

Fish nets: Remove all lead and grass lines, and string pieces. Panel should be clean. *10-2 on the first Saturdays from May thru Oct. Please drop off when the Center is staffed. \$15*

Fluorescent lights: \$1 for 4 ft, \$2 for 8 ft tube
Please drop off when the Center is staffed.

Printer and copier cartridges:
Drop off: HFR, Haines Home Building, Lutak Lumber, or Howsers
