**MATERIALS TAKEN AT FRIENDS OF RECYCLING** (2.5 Mile Small Tracts Rd.) Help us recycle 100% of what we take! PLEASE <u>CLEAN</u> all tin and aluminum cans, <u>REMOVE paper labels</u>, <u>flatten cardboard</u>, and <u>carefully SORT</u> all recyclables.

#### **PAPER PRODUCTS**

White paper: Any white paper that is NOT shiny, including envelopes with windows.

Low grade/mixed paper: \*\* IS NO LONGER ACCEPTED (no longer recyclable).

Cardboard: Corrugated paper boxes - look for ripple layers. Must be flattened.

Shredded White Paper: White paper shredded into strips. Must be tied up in bags.

No cross-shredded paper, too small to recycle.

**Newspaper:** Newsprint only. No colored or shiny inserts.

#### **METAL PRODUCTS**

Copper & brass: Accepted anytime.

**Aluminum cans:** Please rinse. No bags in bins.

Tin cans: Please clean & remove labels.

No aerosol cans.

Refrigerators & Freezers: \$50 fee

Please drop off when the Center is staffed.

Washers, Dryers, & Electric Ranges: \$20 fee Please drop off when the Center is staffed.

Electronics: Bring to Electronic Recycling Day.

**Printer and Copier Cartridges:**
